RINK RULES AND GUIDELINES

Skaters and spectators assume all risks and danger of personal injury arising from or related to admission to the JTF Ice Rink including, but not limited to, being injured by ice skates, ice skaters, spectators, or objects in and around the rink and the building.

- JTF Ice Rink is not responsible for accidents. Skaters skate at their own risk.
- JTF is not responsible for items stolen or left within or near rink or building.
- Persons who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or other substances will be asked to leave the rink.
- Skaters must always obey skate guard's orders. Failure to obey skate guards will result in removal from the rink without refund of admission.
- All skaters aged 10 and under must be supervised at all times by their parents or guardian.
- While on ice, skaters are not allowed to carry children.
- No one except JTF personnel are allowed on the ice without skates.
- No food or beverages allowed on ice or dasher boards.
- Skaters are not allowed to carry loose articles such as purses, backpacks, phones, etc. while skating. JTF does not have lockers. Please leave loose items in your vehicle.
- Skaters and spectators must not sit on, lean over, or leave articles on the dasher boards.
- While on ice, skaters must move in the direction indicated by skate guards.
- Any behavior including but not limited to roughness, excessive speeding, or weaving that interferes with other skaters' safety will result in removal from ice rink.
- While not on ice, walking while wearing rental skates is only permitted on rubber surfaces. Walking on concrete or grass may result in additional charge of \$5 to sharpen skates.
- Socks must be worn at all times when using rental skates.
- Exit must always be kept clear.
- Please use caution entering and exiting the ice.
